

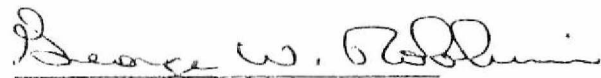
RESOLUTION 92-06

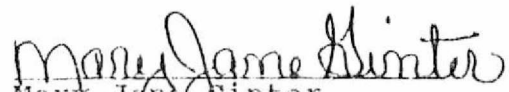
WHEREAS, IT IS CONSIDERED IMPORTANT TO KENTUCKY AND TO THE BLUEGRASS REGION THAT KENTUCKY RIVER LOCKS AND DAMS 5-14 BE IN A REASONABLE STATE OF REPAIR BEFORE THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY ASSUMES THEIR OWNERSHIP AND OPERATION FROM THE ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS, AND

WHEREAS, IT IS CONSIDERED IMPORTANT TO MADISON COUNTY THAT CONSTRUCTION ON LOCKS AND DAMS 9-10 COMMENCE AT AN EARLY DATE, AND

WHEREAS, FEDERAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT OF THESE ACTIVITIES IS SEEN AS CRUCIAL TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THESE TWO PROJECTS AND TO THE OVERALL ECONOMIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND VITALITY OF THE REGION.
