

RESOLUTION 92-08

WHEREAS, the 1991 Special Session of the Kentucky General Assembly passed Senate Bill 2 to promote local recognition of the need for planning for solid waste disposal, and

WHEREAS, Madison County contracted with the Bluegrass Area Development District and received \$10,000.00 from the State of Kentucky to develop a plan for solid waste disposal, and

WHEREAS, the Citizen's Advisory Committee recommended actions amended by the Madison County Fiscal Court, and

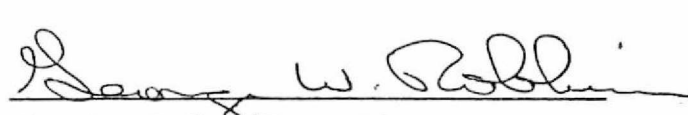
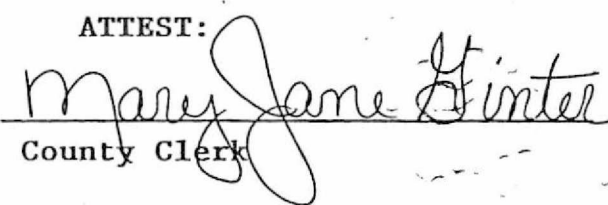
WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court made available for thirty days, the plan for public reading and comment, and

WHEREAS, Madison County is required by KRS 224.887 and 224.888 to submit an area solid waste management plan, and;

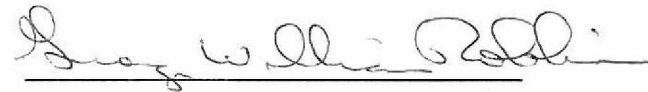
WHEREAS, Madison County has reviewed the plan as prepared by staff at the Bluegrass Area Development District (ADD) in consultation with the County, and;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT

MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT hereby accepts the County Area Solid Waste Management Plan as prepared by the Bluegrass ADD in consultation with the County and submitted for consideration this day. The Fiscal Court authorizes the Bluegrass ADD's Solid Waste Planner to submit the plan to the Kentucky Division of Waste Management after this date with minor revisions to correct typographical errors, and to address style changes, appendix documentation and matters of organization or presentation as may be required by the Division of Waste Management following their review of the plan.
