

RESOLUTION NO. 96- 11

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL AND RELOCATION
OF GRAVES LOCATED ON REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY
RICHMOND INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION AND LOCATED
ON DUNCANNON ROAD, MADISON COUNTY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, the Coroner of Madison County, Embry Curry, and the Richmond Industrial Development Corporation have petitioned the Madison Fiscal Court to relocate a cemetery containing approximately 17 graves located on the real property known as Richmond Industrial Park South II on Duncannon Road in Madison County, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Coroner and Richmond Industrial Development Corporation have complied with KRS 381.750 and KRS 381.755 and no claims have been made within thirty (30) days after the last advertisement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT

1. Embry Curry, the Madison County Coroner, is hereby authorized to remove/relocate a cemetery containing approximately 17 graves located in the Richmond Industrial Park South II referred to above. Further, the graves/cemetery and any right of access, if any, is hereby declared abandoned.
2. The Coroner is further ordered to remove all the graves in said cemetery to the Richmond Cemetery located on East Main Street, Richmond, Madison County, Kentucky.
3. All expenses for the removal and relocation of any graves shall be paid by Richmond Industrial Development Corporation.
4. More than sixty (60) days have passed since the first publication of the intended action hereby pursuant to KRS Chapter 424.

***APPLICATION OF
RICHMOND INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION
AND EMBRY CURRY, THE MADISON COUNTY CORONER,
TO REMOVE AND RELOCATE GRAVES/CEMETERY***

Comes the Richmond Industrial Development Corporation and Embry Curry, the Madison County Coroner, and applies to the Madison County Fiscal Court to remove or relocate a cemetery located near the rear of its property at 219 Duncannon Road, Richmond, Kentucky containing approximately 17 graves to the Richmond Cemetery and further applies to have any right of access, if any, to the aforementioned cemetery/graves declared abandoned.

In support of this application, the owner states as follows:

1. The owner of said property has notified and discussed the removal and/or relocation with all persons that it knows might have an interest in the graves/cemetery and they have unanimously agreed to the removal or relocation to the Richmond Cemetery. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto.

2. All expenses for removal and relocation of the graves/cemetery shall be paid by the Richmond Industrial Development Corporation.

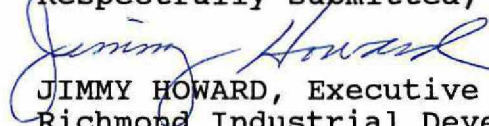
3. All graves/cemetery removed or relocated pursuant to the provisions of this Application shall be relocated to a suitable place, namely the Richmond Cemetery, at the expense of the Richmond Industrial Development Corporation.

4. The graves and/or cemetery have been abandoned and untended for a period in excess of ten (10) years and it is in the best interest of the county and others to remove and relocate the

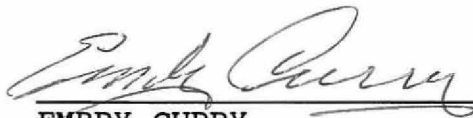
graves and/or cemetery as the property is presently being developed into an Industrial Park. Leaving the graves/cemetery as presently located would be unsuitable and the graves/cemetery would be more properly located in the Richmond Cemetery where they would be properly tended.

5. The disinterment, removal and reinterment of the graves applied for herein shall be performed by duly licensed funeral directors and the Richmond Industrial Development Corporation/Embry Curry, Madison County Coroner, shall obtain all necessary permits.

AUTHORIZATION AND AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned individuals, are direct descendants of Joseph Maupin Terr^lll; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned corporation is the owner of property located at 219 Duncannon Lane; and

WHEREAS, a family cemetery in which members of the Joseph Maupin Terr^lll family are buried is located on the above referenced farm, which is presently being developed into an industrial park; and

WHEREAS, all parties hereto wish to provide a more appropriate and suitable resting place and cemetery for the aforementioned graves and the Richmond Industrial Development Corporation is willing to pay for the expense of properly removing and relocating said graves and complying with all other proper rules and regulations pertaining to the relocation of grave sites, including those set out in KRS Chapter 381; and the parties otherwise agree

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY AGREED AND AUTHORIZED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Richmond Industrial Development Corporation shall, at its expense, relocate the graves presently located at 219 Duncannon Lane to such location as the undersigned hereafter direct.

2. The Richmond Industrial Development Corporation shall ensure that all graves above set out are relocated in a professional manner by a licensed funeral director and the Richmond Industrial Development Corporation shall pay for the purchase of the burial plots.

3. The Richmond Industrial Development Corporation shall obtain all necessary permits and otherwise comply with all the

rules and regulations pertaining to the relocation of grave sites including those rules and regulations as set out in KRS Chapter 381.

4. The graves located on the aforementioned property shall be relocated to Richmond Kentucky Cemetery.
