WHEREAS, traffic has become and will continue to be a major concern in the Fayette and Jessamine areas; and

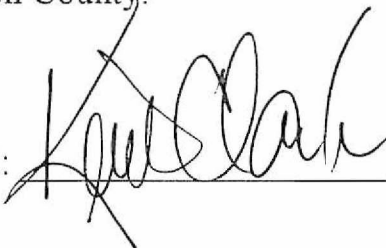
WHEREAS, a connector route that will bring Jessamine and Garrard traffic to I-75 is inevitable; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has asked Madison County Judge Executive to appoint three members to an advisory board to work with the state of Kentucky on the plan.
