WHEREAS, the members of the Madison County Fiscal Court have worked with and listened to the residents of our county for many years to decide the safest and quickest means of disposing of the chemical weapons, and

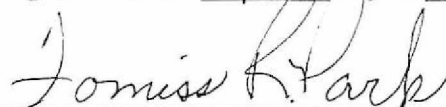

The Madison County Fiscal Court requests the use of qualified local labor, purchasing goods and materials from local businesses or vendors, and taking advantage of existing resources be included in the request for bids, and

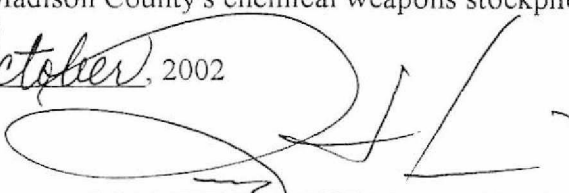
