

RESOLUTION 03- 03

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court desires to create a safe and secure environment for all citizens of Madison County and especially the school children as they are involved in their learning activities by enabling the Madison County Board of Education to have operable school buses ready for an emergency evacuation in response to a chemical agent incident or accident from the Bluegrass Army Depot, and

WHEREAS, these evacuation buses shall be stationed according to the needs of the schools within the immediate response zones, and

WHEREAS, the faculty at each school will need to be trained to operate the buses in the event of an incident, and

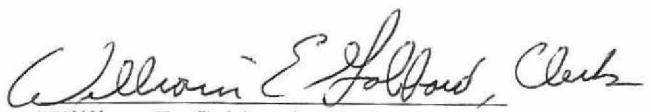
NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Madison County Fiscal Court authorizes Kent Clark, Madison County Judge Executive to sign the Memorandum of Agreements to the Madison County School Board with regard to the 1) Driver Training for Buses on School Grounds for Possible Student Evacuation 2) Purchase of School Buses 3) School Bus Maintenance for Buses Positioned on School Grounds for Possible Student Evacuation 4) Parking Facilities for Evacuation of Buses. And it be further resolved that payments required to be made pursuant to the memorandums shall be release to the Board of Education as such time that the County receives the funding from the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
