

RESOLUTION 06-11

- Whereas,** the Madison County Fiscal Court intends to enact a Tax Amnesty Program that will hopefully encourage the payment of the delinquent occupational taxes due and owing to the County and thereby increase general fund revenue required to maintain services provided to all it's citizens, and
- Whereas,** the Madison County Fiscal Court agrees to enact the Tax Amnesty Program from January 1, 2007 until March 31, 2007; and
- Whereas,** taxpayers who have not filed required returns; taxpayers who are amending their tax liability on previously filed tax returns; taxpayers who have an eligible tax liability and taxpayers who have an outstanding penalty and interest liability as of December 31, 2006 shall be eligible for Amnesty; and
- Whereas,** tax amnesty allows eligible taxpayers to satisfy certain unpaid liabilities and file delinquent returns for the occupational license fee on net profit, and wages without incurring any penalties or interest for occupational taxes which are delinquent as of December 31, 2006.

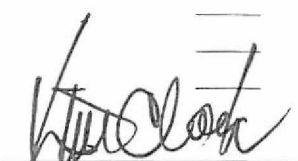

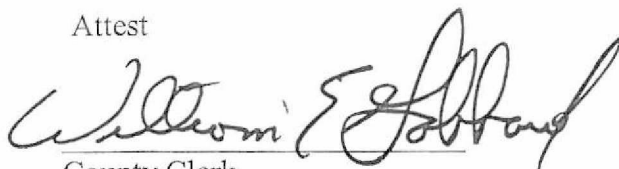
