TO WATER CUSTOMERS OF THE RICHMOND WATER, GAS & SEWERAGE WORKS, MILFORD, KIRKSVILLE, KINGSTON-TERRILL, WHITE HALL, AND WACO WATER DISTRICTS.

Richmond Water, Gas & Sewerage Works will change disinfectants that are used in the potable water on October 1, 2007. At the present chloramines are used. The new disinfectant will be chlorine. The Kentucky Division of Water has reviewed and approved Richmond's plans for the disinfectant change. Richmond's customers will continue to make appropriate adjustments to ensure the quality of our potable water supply.

Aquarium owners should take appropriate precautions when dechlorinating potable water for use in an aquarium. Both chlorine and ammonia are toxic to fish. Sodium sulfite remains one of the best dechlorinating substances for use in conditioning potable water for aquaculture. It is true for water with straight chlorine and for water containing chloramines.
