**RESOLUTION OF MADISON FISCAL COURT
CERTIFICATE OF MADISON COUNTY SHERIFF
AND MADISON COUNTY CLERK**

WHEREAS, House Bill 262 has been adopted by the Kentucky General Assembly and further forwarded to the Governor for his signature and enactment; AND

WHEREAS, the Governor has in fact signed House Bill 262; AND

WHEREAS, House Bill 262 modernizes the procedures for the collection of delinquent tax claims; AND

WHEREAS, Section 4 (a) (2) of House Bill 262 allows counties to suspend the Sheriff's sale of delinquent tax bills under the provisions of KRS 134.450; AND

WHEREAS, by virtue of their signatures set out below, the Madison County Sheriff and the Madison County Clerk do wish to implement the provisions of House Bill 262 effective April 15, 2009 for the collection of 2008 delinquent tax bills and have further made administrative provisions within their respective offices to implement the collection of the Certificates of Delinquency by the Office of the Madison County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Madison County Attorney, Madison County Clerk, and the Madison County Sheriff do wish to implement the provisions of House Bill 262 forthwith for the purpose of maximizing their ability to collect delinquent taxes on behalf of all taxing districts serving the citizens of Madison County, Kentucky;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. **THAT** Madison Fiscal Court, pursuant to the provisions of House Bill 262, as enacted by the Kentucky General Assembly and

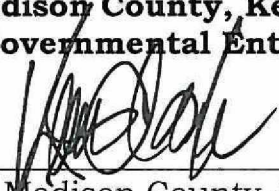
signed into law by the Governor, does hereby authorize the suspension of the Sheriff's sale of delinquent tax bills as otherwise required by KRS 134.450 (3).

2. **THAT** all delinquent tax certificates be transferred from the Madison County Sheriff's Office to the Office of the Madison County Clerk effective April 15, 2009 for the collection of 2008 delinquent tax bills; all in accordance with the enabling provisions of House Bill 262.

3. **THAT** the Office of the Madison County Clerk is authorized to advertise the sale of said delinquent tax certificates in accordance with the provisions of House Bill 262 as enacted by the Kentucky General Assembly.

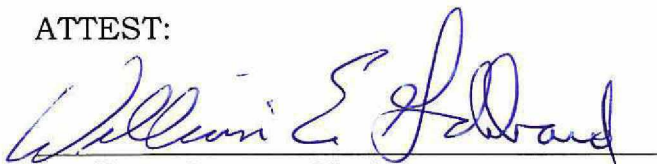
This Resolution was adopted by unanimous consent of Fiscal Court at a regular meeting held on March 24, 2009 a quorum present and voting.

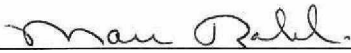
