JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE MADISON FISCAL COURT,

CITY OF RICHMOND, KENTUCKY, AND CITY OF BERE, KENTUCKY

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE MADISON FISCAL COURT, CITY OF RICHMOND, KENTUCKY, AND CITY OF BERE, KENTUCKY PROTESTING THE PROPOSED REDISTRICTING OF REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICTS INVOLVING MADISON COUNTY.

WHEREAS, a proposal has been circulated by the leadership of the Kentucky General Assembly which would divide Madison County among five state representative districts, the 88th, 73rd, 80th, 81st, and 91st; and

WHEREAS, Madison County is currently represented by legislators in three districts, the 36th, 73rd, and 81st; and

WHEREAS, the 2010 census lists the ideal population of a state representative district at 43,394, with a 10% deviation allowed; and

WHEREAS, Madison County has a 2010 population of 82,916; and

WHEREAS, the goals of a fair, efficient, balanced, and constitutional redistricting plan are to apportion districts with a population that deviates not more than 10% from the ideal population and also respects the integrity of the county unit by keeping its legislative districts as compact and unified as possible; and

WHEREAS, Madison County can comply with constitutional redistricting requirements and receive two representative districts within its county boundaries;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Madison Fiscal Court, City Commission of the City of Richmond, Kentucky, and the City Council of the City of Berea, Kentucky, acting jointly on behalf of its 82,916 citizens, that the proposed plan imposing five districts on Madison County be rejected and that Madison County be assigned two legislative districts within the county, modified appropriately to meet the 10% deviation factor, consisting of the 81st and another district within the county adjusted appropriately so that Madison County is allowed legislative representation from within its county boundary lines.

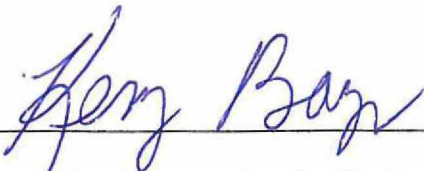
This joint resolution shall be effective when it has been duly approved and executed.

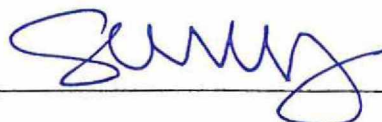
