WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court is committed to providing a recreational park system to promote a healthier citizen body; and

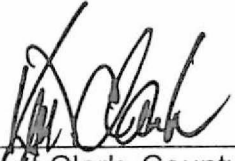
WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court feels the recreational system shall exhibit components of cultural, natural, historical, and educational features for its community; and

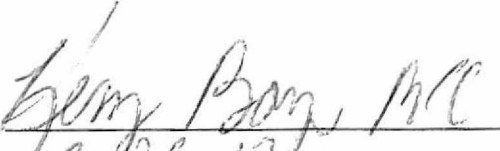
WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court wants to increase the numbers and types of facilities in the park system; and
