

RESOLUTION 15-01

MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT RESOLUTION ADOPTING ROADWAYS FOR COUNTY ROAD MAINTENANCE

Whereas, **Durbin Lane** was adopted into the Madison County Road System for County Maintenance on May 13, 2014 by the Madison County Fiscal Court and the Fiscal Court minutes of record needs clarification recorded for this road(*minutes used Derby Lane*). The road was inspection by the Madison County Road Department and meets the required standards for the Madison County Road Maintenance System. **Durbin Lane** is 680 feet at 16 feet wide and 1353 feet at 12 feet wide and to be taken in as is and meeting the county minimum standard for a blacktop roadway for a rural subdivision; and

Whereas, 940' of **Taylor's Fork Road** in Madison County was adopted into the Madison County Road system for County Maintenance on October 14, 2014 by the Fiscal Court. Total Maintenance for this road is now 3,188 feet.

Now therefore, let the record show the above roads as adopted into the Madison County Road System and also send notification of these roadways to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet.
