

RESOLUTION NO. 15-02

MADISON COUNTY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, the Northern Madison Co. Sanitation District, a public subdivision of the Madison County Government, Madison County, Kentucky, proposes to install a public wastewater collection and transportation system in Madison County beginning at 2819 Robbinsville Loop Rd continuing southeast to 3101 Old Irvine rd.(0.8miles total) to serve the citizens in the Greens Crossing area.

WHEREAS, the installations of the aforesaid wastewater collection and transportation lines will, in part, entail utilization of rights-of-way for the roadways maintained by the MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the **MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT** that we endorse the aforesaid wastewater collection and transportation project to serve the above mentioned areas; and hereby grant permission for utilization of County Road Rights-of-Way, with the understanding that all damages resulting from the proposed wastewater collection and transportation sewer lines along and/or across the roadways in question shall be promptly repaired, to equal or better condition prior to construction of the aforesaid improvements, by the contractor of the Sanitation District.
