

RESOLUTION NO. 17-07

**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING OWNERSHIP
AND MAINTENANCE OF OLD US25
FROM STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, by this Order, the duly elected representatives of Madison County, hereby called the County, are hereby notified that the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, hereinafter called the Cabinet, has reconstructed a state road, designated as US 25;

WHEREAS, construction of said US 25 and approaches have been completed;

WHEREAS, because the remaining old roadbed and associated right-of-way was not addressed and transferred to the appropriate entity, and the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet attains no benefit from this right-of-way and remaining road segments which will primarily serve a local purpose and are no longer germane to the statewide transportation network; and

WHEREAS, the county agrees to accept all rights and responsibilities for ownership, maintenance and utility accommodation, and will accept as part of their local road system the roadway described as:

OLD US 25, beginning at a point lying on the eastern right-of-way line of US 25 (Mount Vernon Road) , approximately 80 feet right of approximate Station 827+25, extending southeasterly along the center of Old US 25 roadbed to the county line, an approximate distance of 264 feet. (MP 0.000 to MP 0.050)

The existing road segment is no longer part of the reconstructed US 25, and has been deemed a discontinued state facility and is closed to public use and has been determined by the Cabinet to have no statewide or regional purpose, and, therefore, will be eliminated from the Kentucky State Primary Road System by Official Order of the Cabinet.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County will execute this Resolution and, thus, hereby accept the old roadbed and agree to these conditions, and that a signed copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Cabinet by Madison County, Kentucky.

The foregoing resolution was adopted as above set forth by majority roll call vote of all members of the city council or county fiscal court present, a quorum being constituted and said resolution has been duly made a permanent part of the minutes of the city council or county fiscal court.
