

MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT

RESOLUTION 17- 27

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court proposes to develop and renovate facilities by increasing the off-road facilities for pedestrian, bike, and other non-motorized forms of transportation as well as increasing community, historic, cultural, and recreational resources to provide for the health and well being of the public, and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court intends to make an application to the Department of Transportation for assistance from the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP), federally funded by the Federal Highway Administration, and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Alternatives Program is limited to eighty percent (80%) of proposed project costs associated with the grant application.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Madison County Fiscal hold in reserve twenty percent (20%) of the proposed project costs including cash and in-kind costs for the purpose of matching the (TAP) Transportation Alternative Program assistance, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event a grant is awarded, the Madison County Fiscal Court understands that it will sign assurances to comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, rules and regulations, especially Title VI of the Civil Rights Act and Section 504 of the 1973 Rehabilitation Act.
