

RESOLUTION 18-03

A RESOLUTION BY MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT AFFIRMING SUPPORT FOR A SCENIC BIKE ROUTE

WHEREAS, bicycle tourism is a growing industry in North America, contributing over \$70 billion dollars a year to the economies of communities that provide facilities for such tourists; and

WHEREAS, the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials has designed a corridor crossing Kentucky to be developed as United States Bike Route 21 (USBR21); and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court with the cooperation of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) and other stakeholders, have proposed a specific route to be designated as USBR21, a map of which is herein incorporated into this resolution by reference; and

WHEREAS, the proposed route for USBR 21 comes through Madison County and can therefore provide a benefit to our residents and businesses; and

WHEREAS, we have investigated the proposed route and found it to be a suitable route, and desire that the route be designated so that it can be mapped and signed, there by promoting bicycle tourism in our area.

NOW THERE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF MADISON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, that it hereby expresses its approval and support for the development of USBR 21, and requests that the appropriate officials see to it that the route is officially designated by the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials as soon as this can be achieved, and authorizes the posting of signs within the Madison County right-of-way identifying the route through the community once the official designation has been made.
