

RESOLUTION 18-16

CERTIFICATION OF THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT REGARDING AN ANTI-DISPLACEMENT AND RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PLAN AS REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 104 (d) OF THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1974, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, Section 104(d), requires the County to replace all occupied and vacant, occupiable low/moderate dwelling units demolished or converted to use other than as low/moderate income housing where demolition or conversion is a direct result of activities assisted with Community Development Block Grant funds; and,

WHEREAS, The Madison County Fiscal Court has applied for and received funding for a Community Development Block Grant for the God's Outreach Food Bank Expansion Project (16-030); and,

WHEREAS, The Madison County Fiscal Court will not demolish or replace any occupied or vacant occupiable low/moderate income dwelling units as a result of this proposed Community Development Block Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT CERTIFIED by The Madison County Fiscal Court that:

1. The proposed Community Development Block Grant Program will involve the acquisition of one (1) parcel.
2. To be consistent with the goals and objectives of activities assisted under Section 104(d) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended, the County will take the following steps to minimize displacement of persons from their homes as a result of this project:
