

MADISON COUNTY

WHEREAS, Kentucky Emergency Management (KYEM) planning guidance requires counties to have at least one Incident Specific Plan (ISP) focused around a specific large-scale incident or event (major disaster); and

WHEREAS, Madison County has developed an Incident Specific Plan, the CSEPP ISP, to prepare for a hazard unique to Madison County and the surrounding region - the storage of chemical agents (VX, GB, and H) within the Blue Grass Chemical Activity (BGCA) area on the Blue Grass Army Depot (BGAD); and

WHEREAS, the CSEPP ISP describes the responsibilities of local, state, and federal government agencies in the event of a chemical agent (CSEPP) accident/incident at BGAD and establishes guidelines for coordinating local, state and federal emergency responses; and

WHEREAS, the original CSEPP ISP, dated April 4, 2014, was approved by Executive Order dated May 27, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the CSEPP ISP was reviewed and approved by Kentucky Emergency Management on June 6, 2014 and a concurrence letter issued; and

WHEREAS, as part of plan maintenance and to add additional information requested by KYEM, the CSEPP ISP was subsequently updated December 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Madison County Office of Emergency Management has submitted the updated December 2018 Madison County CSEPP ISP to the County Judge/Executive for official approval and adoption as requested by KYEM; and

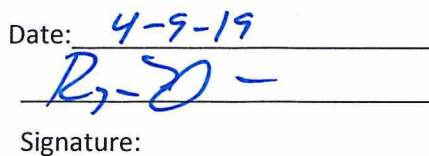
NOW, THEREFORE, I *Reagan Taylor* Judge/ Executive, by the virtue of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, do hereby order and direct the following:

1. The (updated) December 2018 Madison County CSEPP ISP is officially approved and adopted effective the date of this Executive Order as shown herein.
2. The conveyance of the official approval and adoption of the Madison County CSEPP ISP through this Executive Order shall remain continuously in effect from the date of this Executive Order as shown herein, or until superseded by a subsequent Executive Order promulgated in accordance with KRS 39B.030(3), KRS 39B.060(2), KRS 39C.050(3), applicable Kentucky Administrative Regulations, and planning guidance issued by the Kentucky Division of Emergency Management.
3. A copy of the officially approved and adopted the December 2018 Madison County CSEPP ISP, including this Executive Order, shall be placed on file for public inspection during regular office hours in the Madison County Office of the County Judge/Executive.
