**A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE ORDINANCE #19-14 AD VALOREM TAX FOR MADISON
COUNTY, KENTUCKY**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court wishes to communicate to the public and any future Fiscal Court the intention of this ad valorem property tax; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court understands they cannot mandate a future Fiscal Court to any future financial obligation, they hope the intent of this Fiscal Court is honored; and

WHEREAS, the rate increase is intended solely for the construction and operation of the Madison County Detention Center; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the construction bond, the Madison County Fiscal Court wishes the rate would be reduced to only cover the operating expenses for the Detention Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Fiscal Court of the County of Madison, Commonwealth of Kentucky, that the Ad Valorem Rate set for the bond portion be sunsetted at the conclusion of the final bond payment.

THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON THE DATE OF THE READING AND ADOPTION.
