RESOLUTION 20-04**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A ROAD TRANSFER FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF
KENTUCKY TO MADISON COUNTY**

WHEREAS, WHEREAS, the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (hereinafter "Cabinet") reconstructed a portion of Kentucky Highway 52 between the Garrard County/ Madison County line and the intersection of Wallace Mill Road, which is approximately a 1.3 mile distance, as part of Project Numbers FD52 040 0052 013-017 / FD52 076 0052 000-002, Item Number 7-201.0 (hereinafter "Project"). The Cabinet's Plan Sheets detailing the constructed Project are attached hereto this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the construction of the aforementioned Project by the Cabinet resulted in certain sections of the old Kentucky Highway 52 as well as connector roads, approach roads, and other property owned and maintained by the Cabinet no longer being needed by the Cabinet for the Commonwealth of Kentucky's Primary Road System; and

WHEREAS, the Cabinet seeks to eliminate from the Commonwealth of Kentucky's Primary Road System certain road facilities more specifically defined in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Cabinet has offered to transfer all of the Commonwealth of Kentucky's interest and ownership in those certain road facilities more specifically defined in Exhibit A attached hereto this Resolution to the Madison County Fiscal Court (hereinafter "Fiscal Court"); and

WHEREAS, upon the Fiscal Court's adoption and approval of this Resolution the Cabinet will furnish an Official Order detailing the transfer of all of the Commonwealth's interest and ownership in those certain road facilities more specifically defined in Exhibit A to the Fiscal Court; and

WHEREAS, the Official Order will request the Secretary of the Finance and Administration Cabinet transfer the Commonwealth of Kentucky's interest in those certain road facilities more specifically defined in Exhibit A to the Fiscal Court by the necessary conveyance document; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court will assume all maintenance responsibilities for the certain road facilities more specifically defined in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court will name the section of the road adopted by the County as Jubilee Lane; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court has reviewed this Resolution, the Cabinet's Plan Sheets attached hereto, and Exhibit A, which more specifically defines the certain road facilities that will be transferred to the Fiscal Court, and recommends approval of same.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FISCAL COURT THAT THIS RESOLUTION IS HEREBY APPROVED, AND THAT THE COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE FISCAL COURT.
