FOR SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL FUNDING REQUEST**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Sheriff has identified a candidate for hire in a Deputy Sheriff position; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Sheriff's Department sets their annual budget at the beginning of the calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the position is replacing a former retired employee that was ineligible for benefits with a candidate the agency is required to provide benefits for; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Sheriff's Department budget needs to be supplemented with \$6,404.70 for the remainder of the fiscal year 2020 for a total annual increase in fiscal year 2021 of \$ 25,618.80 to cover the benefit costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION.

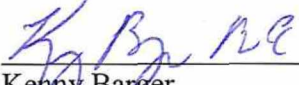

Reference: Supplement Benefit Adjustment pay for MCSO Deputy Position.

To: Judge Executive, Reagan Taylor and Fiscal Court Magistrates.

I am requesting financial assistance from the Fiscal Court, in the sum of \$25,618.80, to be allocated for benefits. This pay will supplement the adjustment change in status from a Retiree Deputy position with salary only and no benefits to a fulltime Deputy Status position, with salary and benefits.

Deputy Tim Craft, resigned from our agency in January of 2020, after the MCSO 2020 budget had been approved and was in effect. This position still remains vacant to date, we haven't been able to fill the position because it requires a Retired Certified Law Enforcement Officer.

My request is to make this position a full time with benefits due to manpower shortage and scheduling conflict issues.
