**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SIGNATURE OF A MEMORANDUM OF
AGREEMENT FOR AUTOMATIC AID FIRE SERVICE BETWEEN MADISON
COUNTY FISCAL COURT AND CARTERSVILLE/PAINT LICK VOLUNTEER FIRE
AND RESCUE, INC.**

WHEREAS, each party has the power, control and responsibility to provide fire and rescue services within their respective boundaries; and

WHEREAS, due to the close proximity of the Cartersville/Paint Lick Fire and Rescue Station to Madison County, the Madison County Fiscal Court wishes to enter into an Automatic Aid Agreement with Cartersville/Paint Lick Volunteer Fire and Rescue, Inc

WHEREAS, the geographical boundary for aid is defined as 5 road miles from the respective station into Madison County per ISO; and

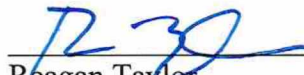
WHEREAS, the parties entering into this agreement agree to provide the following services if it is available by the providing agency; emergency services, including basic medical support, hazardous material containment and confinement, and special rescue events including vehicular collision extrication, water rescue, water recovery, trench, building, and confined space rescue, missing persons; and

WHEREAS, automatic aid agreements ensure that citizens, regardless of their geographical location receive quality first response in times of need.

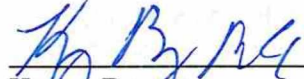

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT
AND
CARTERSVILLE/PAINT LICK VOLUNTEER FIRE AND RESCUE, INC.
FOR AUTOMATIC AID**

This agreement ("Agreement") entered into between the Madison County Fiscal Court "County" and the Cartersville/Paint Lick Volunteer Fire and Rescue, Inc. "Volunteer" for automatic aid.

In consideration of the mutual commitments herein contained, and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. On receipt of a 911 phone call to the Volunteer's Joint 911 Dispatch Center, County firefighting equipment and personnel of the requested entity will be dispatched when available to any point within the area for which the City normally provides fire protection as designated by the geographical boundaries.
2. On receipt of a 911 phone call to the Madison County Joint 911 Dispatch Center, Partner firefighting equipment and personnel of the requested entity will be dispatched when available to any point within the area for which the County normally provides fire protection as designated by the geographical boundaries.
3. The rendering of assistance under the terms of this agreement shall not be mandatory, but the party receiving the request for assistance shall immediately inform the requesting department, if, for any reason, assistance cannot be rendered.
4. The automatic aid shall consist of one tanker capable of dumping water at a rate of no less than 250 gallons per minute and sufficient manpower to operate the tanker with no less than two fighters.
5. Any dispatch of equipment and personnel pursuant to this agreement is subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Any request for aid under this agreement will specify the location to which the equipment and personnel are to be dispatched; however, the amount and type of equipment and number of personnel to be furnished will be determined by a representative of the responding agency.
 - b. The responding organization will report to the officer in charge of the requesting organization at the location to which the equipment is dispatched and will be subject to the orders of the official.
 - c. A responding organization will be released by the requesting organization when the services of the responding organization are no longer required, or when the responding organization is needed within the area for which it normally provides fire protection.

5. Each party hereby waives all claims against the other party for compensation for any loss, damage, injury or death occurring as a consequence of the performance of this agreement.
6. The chief fire officers and personnel of the fire departments of both parties are invited and encouraged, on a reciprocal basis, to frequently visit each other's activities for guided familiarization tours to jointly conduct pre-fire planning inspection drills.
7. The technical heads of the fire departments of the parties to this agreement are authorized and directed to meet and draft any detailed plans and procedures of operation necessary to effectively implement this agreement. Such plans and procedures of operations shall become effective upon ratification by the signatory parties.
8. This agreement shall become effective upon the date hereof and remain in full force and effect until cancelled by mutual agreement of the parties hereto or by written notice by one party to the other party, giving thirty (30) days' notice of said cancellation.
9. All parties entering into this agreement will ensure their departmental contact information is kept current with the other department.
10. This Agreement and any attachments/schedules constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior agreements or understandings as to the subject matter herein. Any modifications or amendments to this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be signed by each party.
