**A RESOLUTION TO AWARD EACH FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE 2 PERSONAL DAYS
TO BE USED IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 AS A ONE TIME BENEFIT**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court has decided due to the COVID-19 pandemic and unknown impact it will have on the Fiscal Court financially, to award each full-time employee two personal days to be used during the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year; and

WHEREAS, the 2 personal days may not be cashed out but used in the same manner as personal hours as outlined in the Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court will re-evaluate the financial situation of the County at a later date to reassess if the budget would allow for years of service and employee classification raises; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court has established an Employee Classification System and Years of Service for the benefit of all employees of the Fiscal Court; and

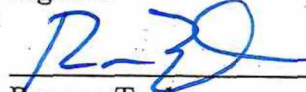
WHEREAS, the Employee Classification System is updated annually.

APPROVE THE 2020/2021 CLASSIFICATION SCHEDULE.**

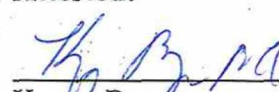
