**A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF MADISON, KENTUCKY AND THE CITY OF
RICHMOND, KENTUCKY FOR THE FY21 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL
JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court desires to enter into an Interlocal Agreement between the County of Madison, Kentucky, hereinafter referred to as County, and the City of Richmond, Kentucky, hereinafter referred to as City; and

WHEREAS, the County agrees to serve as the applicant/fiscal agent for the FY21 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program award; and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County agrees to provide the City \$5,696.00 from the FY21 JAG program award of \$11,392.00 to be used by the Richmond Police Department, and County agrees to use the remaining \$5,696.00 from the FY21 JAG program award for the Madison County Sheriff's Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.

**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF RICHMOND, KY AND COUNTY OF MADISON, KY**

FY21 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD

This Agreement is made and entered into this 15th day of July, 2021, by and between The CITY OF RICHMOND, acting by and through its governing body, the City Commission, hereinafter referred to as CITY, and the COUNTY OF MADISON, acting by and through its governing body, the Fiscal Court, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, both of MADISON County, State of KENTUCKY, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make performance of those payments from current revenues legally available to that party: and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this agreement: and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY agrees to serve as the applicant/fiscal agent for the FY21 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant program award; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY agrees to provide the CITY \$5,696.00 from the FY21 JAG program award of \$11,392.00 to be used by the Richmond Police Department and the COUNTY agrees to use the remaining \$5,696.00 from the FY21 JAG program award for the Madison County Sheriff's Department.

NOW THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CITY agree as follows:

Section 1.

CITY agrees to use their portion (\$5,696.00) of the JAG program award for the purchase of equipment for the Richmond Police Department to enhance public safety, enhance officer safety, and improve law enforcement capabilities.

Section 2.

COUNTY agrees to use their portion (\$5,696.00) of the JAG program award for the purchase of equipment for the Madison County Sheriff's Office to enhance public safety, enhance officer safety, and improve law enforcement capabilities.

Section 3.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against COUNTY and or CITY.

Section 4.

Each party to this agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

Section 5.

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.

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Section 6.

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intend to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out herein; further, this Agreement shall not create any rights for any party not a signatory hereto.

**AN ORDER OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, KENTUCKY ADOPTING AN
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE COUNTY AND
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE
CITY**

WHEREAS, the City and Madison County are in the process of applying for a 2021 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program Award ("JAG Award"); and

WHEREAS, the parties to the application do wish to enter into an agreement detailing the means whereby the proceeds from the JAG Award will be divided between them and the purpose to which such proceeds will be applied should the application be approved;
