SHELTER-IN-PLACE (SIP) KIT PROJECT COMPLETION

WHEREAS, the Madison County CSEP Program requires maximum protection to our community; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County CSEP Program SIP Project was placed out to bid in 2019 with only one bid received; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County CSEP Program worked successfully to fulfill the project with the vendor awarded the bid (Pioneer Vocational/Industrial Services) until funding was depleted; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County CSEP Program's previous bids only identified one vender (Pioneer Vocational/Industrial Services) and the work performed was completed satisfactorily; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County CSEP Program now has additional funding to complete the SIP Kit Project and would like to continue the effort with Pioneer; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County CSEP Program would like to ask the Fiscal Court's permission to proceed with purchasing these SIP kits through a not feasible to bid so that Madison County CSEPP could complete this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.

CSEPP Shelter-In-Place (SIP) Kit Project – Not Feasible to Bid

The CSEPP SIP kit project was placed out for bid in 2019, with only one bid received. The bid received was from Pioneer and the project was awarded to them in June of 2019. The goal of the project was to provide SIP kits to all residences and businesses in Madison County. However, the funding for the project was depleted before we were able to reach that goal.

Additional CSEPP funding is now available to complete the project. Since Pioneer worked with us to develop the packaging, contents, and delivery routes; and still has the data for those addresses that have been delivered to versus those that have not we would like to request a not feasible to bid.

The original bid acceptance between Madison County and Pioneer did not have a time limit for expiration. There has been an increase in per unit cost from the original \$35.97 to \$40.71 due to an increase in the cost of the supplies included in the SIP kit as well as an increase in the cost of postage. When the project was placed out for bid in 2019, Pioneer was the only vendor to place a bid on the project.

We would like to request a not feasible to bid and utilize Pioneer to complete the CSEPP SIP project.
