**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT BETWEEN MADISON
COUNTY FISCAL COURT AND KNOX COUNTY FISCAL COURT TO HOUSE
ADULT MADISON COUNTY PRISONERS AT THE KNOX COUNTY
DETENTION CENTER IN KNOX COUNTY, KENTUCKY**

WHEREAS, during necessary times, the Madison County Fiscal Court requires the use of other detention centers to provide temporary housing to adult Madison County prisoners; and

WHEREAS, Jailer Steve Tussey wishes to enter into a contract with Knox County Fiscal Court at a rate of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per day, for each Madison County prisoner housed at the Knox County Detention Center; and

WHEREAS, the duration of this Agreement shall be for a period of one (1) year from the date signed with automatic renewals every year following, or until terminated by a participating party upon written notice; and

WHEREAS, in the event of termination of this Agreement, Madison County will have up to (60) days from the date of written termination in which to remove its inmates from the Knox County Detention Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE TO ENTER INTO THE CONTRACT AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.

CONTRACT TO HOUSE ADULT MADISON COUNTY PRISONERS

1. Parties

The Madison County Fiscal Court (with the consent of the Madison County Jailer) and the Knox County Fiscal Court (with the consent of the Knox County Jailer) agree to house adult Madison County prisoners at the Knox County Detention Center in Knox County, Kentucky.

2. Definition of "Adult Madison County Prisoner"

Any prisoner, eighteen (18) years of age or older, with criminal or civil contempt charges pending, originating, or disposed of in Madison County.

3. Rate of Pay

The Madison County Fiscal Court agrees to pay Knox County Fiscal Court thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per day, for each Madison County prisoner housed at the Knox County Detention Center.

4. Calculation of a Day

The per-day charge will be distinguished by which facility feeds the prisoner two (2) meals in a twenty-four (24) hour period.

5. Use of Other Jails

The Madison County Fiscal Court reserves the right to simultaneously contract with any other county to house all or any portion of its prisoners.

6. Refusal of Prisoners

The Knox County Detention Center reserves the right to refuse to accept Madison County prisoners under the following conditions:

- A. When the Detention Center becomes overcrowded;
- B. When the prisoner needs immediate medical or psychological treatment;
- C. When the prisoner poses an extreme risk to the security of the Jail.

7. Inmate Billing Invoices

The Knox County Detention Center shall submit a monthly inmate billing invoice to the Madison County Fiscal Court. The Madison County Fiscal Court shall promptly pay the amount due to the Knox County Fiscal Court.

8. Medical Bills

The Madison County Fiscal Court shall be responsible for paying the bills of any and all outside healthcare providers incurred by Madison County prisoners housed in the Knox County Detention Center, including but not limited to the cost of medication, doctor bills, dental bills, hospital bills, ambulance bills, etc.

While Madison County prisoners are housed in the Knox County Detention Center, Knox County Detention Center agrees to provide the same quality medical care to the Madison County prisoners as is provided to all other County and State inmates held in the facility.

Additionally, the Knox County Detention Center has developed cost-effective relationships with local medical and dental care providers.

9. Medical Co-Payments

The Knox County Detention Center shall be allowed to charge Madison County prisoners reasonable medical co-payments, in addition to the amounts charged by outside healthcare providers, in efforts to reimburse the Detention Center for the cost of providing medical services to Madison County prisoners. Madison County Fiscal Court will not be charged for these co-payments.

10. Court Transport and Security

It shall be the responsibility of the Madison County Fiscal Court to provide transportation and/or security personnel for Madison County court appearances.

11. Effective Date

This Agreement shall become effective on the 8TH day of MARCH, 20 22 with automatic renewals every year following.

12. Termination

This Agreement can be terminated by either party by submitting written notice to the other party. Madison County will have up to sixty (60) days from the date of written termination in which to remove its inmates from the Knox County Detention Center.

13. Terms of Agreement

The duration of this Agreement shall be for a period of one (1) year from the date signed, with automatic renewals every year following or until terminated by a participating party upon thirty (30) days' written notice.
