**A RESOLUTION FOR APPLICATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF CALENDAR
YEAR 2023 KENTUCKY ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT CABINET DIVISION OF
WASTE MANAGEMENT LITTER ABATEMENT GRANT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, THE KENTUCKY ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT CABINET DIVISION OF WASTE MANAGEMENT CALENDAR YEAR 2023 LITTER ABATEMENT GRANT ALLOWS UNITS OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO APPLY FOR LITTER ABATEMENT GRANT FUNDS TO BE USED FOR: (1) DIRECT EXPENSES AS DEFINED IN 401 KAR 49:080 SECTION 3 INCURRED DURING CALENDAR YEAR 2023 ASSOCIATED WITH ANTI-LITTER CONTROL PROGRAMS, (2) FOR LITTER CLEANUP ON PUBLIC ROADS AS PROVIDED IN KRS 224.43-505, (3) TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED IN KRS 224.43-345; AND

WHEREAS, THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT, KENTUCKY, DESIRES TO MAKE AN APPLICATION FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2023 LITTER ABATEMENT GRANT FUNDS; AND

WHEREAS, THE COUNTY OF MADISON, KENTUCKY, WISHES TO AUTHORIZE THE JUDGE EXECUTIVE AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2023 LITTER ABATEMENT GRANT FUNDS, AND IF THE APPLICATION IS SUCCESSFUL, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DIVISION OF WASTE MANAGEMENT TO ADMINISTER THE CALENDAR YEAR 2023 LITTER ABATEMENT GRANT AWARD, TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS WHICH ARE DEEMED NECESSARY TO FACILITATE AND ADMINISTER THE AWARD, TO ACT AS THE AUTHORIZED CORRESPONDENT FOR THIS AWARD; AND

WHEREAS, THE AMOUNT OF FUNDING AVAILABLE PER COUNTY WILL BE CALCULATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS AND THE AMOUNT OF GRANT FUNDING EACH COUNTY IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE WILL NOT BE DETERMINED UNTIL AFTER NOVEMBER 1, 2022, WHEN ALL APPLICATIONS ARE RECEIVED BY THE DIVISION OF WASTE MANAGEMENT; AND

WHEREAS, THERE IS NO LOCAL MATCH REQUIRED;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THIS 23RD DAY OF AUGUST 2022, BY MADISON COUNTY, KENTUCKY THE JUDGE EXECUTIVE AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE AND FURNISH ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION, INCLUDING MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENTS, AS MAY BE REQUIRED FOR THE FURTHERANCE OF THE ABOVE-REFERENCED PROJECT AND TO ACT AS THE AUTHORIZED CORRESPONDENT FOR SAID PROJECT.

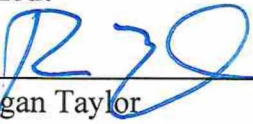

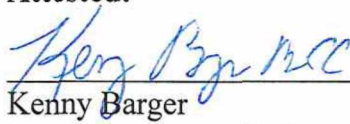

4. TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR GRANT FUNDING			
4(a).	The grantee shall conduct three litter cleanups along public roads each year as required by KRS 224.43-345 and 401 KAR 49:080, Section 3(1) in accordance with 401 KAR 49:080 Section 1(5). A public road cleanup is defined as the "cleanup of litter along a number of public road miles equivalent to one-third (1/3) of the total public road miles in the solid waste management area, excluding total city street miles".		
4(b).	Unless the incorporated city received litter abatement grant funding, the grantee shall conduct litter cleanups along city streets two (2) times per year in accordance with 401 KAR 49:080 Section 1(5). A city street cleanup is defined as the "cleanup of litter along a number of city street miles equivalent to one-half (1/2) of a city's total street miles".		
4(c).	The amount of litter abatement program grant funding is determined in accordance with KRS 224.43-505 and the total number of applicants applying for the grant.		
4(d).	The litter abatement program grant funding shall be used for direct expenses, as defined in 401 KAR 49:080 Section 1(2), incurred during the calendar year which the grant is distributed, associated with litter abatement programs, for litter cleanup on public roads and city streets as provided in KRS 224.43-505, and to meet the requirements established in KRS 224.43-345.		
4(e).	By March 1, of the year following the grant distribution, the grantee shall submit a completed "Solid Waste Management Area Annual Report", DEP 6061, to the cabinet.		
4(f).	Litter abatement program grant funds not spent during the calendar year shall be submitted to the cabinet by April 15 th the year following grant distribution.		
5. CERTIFICATION			
The county hereby applies for grant funding for litter abatement program activities allowed pursuant to KRS 224.43-505, and agree to the above terms and conditions. I am aware that KRS 224.99-010(4) provides for penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment for knowing violations.
