RESOLUTION 2022-110**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DISCONTINUANCE OF
CEDARWOOD DRIVE, GINGERTREE LANE, AND A PORTION OF BROOKWOOD DRIVE,
AND AUTHORIZING THEIR REMOVAL FROM THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court is responsible for the maintenance of Madison County roadways;
and

WHEREAS, KRS 178.116 outlines certain requirements for the discontinuance of county roadways; and

WHEREAS, Cedarwood Drive and Gingertree Lane meet the requirements of KRS 178.116, as follows:

- a) A public need is not served by the roads;
- b) The roads do not provide necessary access for a private person;
- c) The roads have not been maintained and policed by the County or State within a three (3) year period.

WHEREAS, all of Cedarwood Drive, all of Gingertree Lane, and approximately 82.58 feet of the southwest portion of Brookwood Drive will be removed from the County Road System and returned to the property owner;
and

WHEREAS, approximately 152 feet of Brookwood Drive will remain in the County Road System; and

WHEREAS, the properties contiguous to the above roadways will continue to be accessible via Highway 627 and Brookwood Drive;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE EXECUTIVE AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.
