**A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT TO SERVE AS
THE APPLICANT AGENT FOR THE FY23 GENERAL ASAP GRANT AND AUTHORIZING
THE JUDGE EXECUTIVE TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court, at the request of the Madison County Agency for Substance Abuse Policy, assists in providing resources to enhance the health and well-being of the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court will act as the applicant agent for the Madison County Agency for Substance Abuse Policy (ASAP) to make an application to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, Office of Drug Control Policy, for assistance to affect alcohol and substance abuse issues in Madison County and to increase drug prevention and awareness activities funded by the program; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County ASAP funding request is limited to \$20,000.00 for the 2023 Agency for Substance Abuse Policy Funding Year;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Madison County Fiscal Court assist the Madison County Agency for Substance Abuse Policy acting as the fiscal agent for the purpose of providing services necessary for the program fiscal operation of the Agency; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event a grant is awarded, the Madison County Fiscal Court understands that it will sign assurances to comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, rules, and regulations, especially Title VI of the Civil Rights Act and Section 504 of the 1973 Rehabilitation Act.

Administrative

\$300: Dues, Fees, Meeting Expenses: Richmond and Berea Chamber of Commerce

Prevention

\$1,000: Richmond Police Department Summer Youth Program: ASAP pays for transportation costs for at-risk youth attending activities during this week of camp.

\$500: Educational Forum: ASAP will bring in high-quality speakers to present to the community on a relevant ATOD topic.

\$1,000: Prevention Billboards: Billboards will be placed throughout the county.

\$500: Madison Central At-Risk Student Prevention Program: High-Risk students at Madison Central participate in a program to increase resilience and decrease risk factors.

Treatment

\$2,500: Support for SPARK: This program is on the streets in high-risk neighborhoods providing treatment resources and other connections.

\$1,200: Recovery Wagon: This organization provides peer support volunteers to drive people to treatment programs anywhere in the state.

\$2,500: Achieving Recovery Together (ART): This comprehensive recovery support program provides peer support to emergency departments, social services, and any other community program who serves people with substance use disorder. They are expanding to Madison County from Clark County.

\$2,500: Dry Dock: This non-profit provides recovery support in Richmond, including meeting space, peer support, and other community resources.

\$3,000: Madison County Detention Center: The Detention Center is creating a culture of recovery by providing guest speakers, meetings, and recovery resources.

\$2,500: The Kentucky Crusades: This new local non-profit supports families who have experienced an overdose by providing linkage to resources and support for meeting the needs of the whole family.

\$2,500: Peer Support Training Scholarships: The Training Center offers training for people in recovery to become certified peer support specialists. This funding will pay for 13 Madison County residents who are in recovery to complete this training.
