2022-2023 Road Salt Bid Award Review and Recommendations

We requested sealed bids for Deicing Road Salt to see if we received a lower price than what we received from the KACO Reverse Salt Auction. A total of 3 bids were received 2 from Compass Minerals America, Inc. and 1 from Morton Salt, Inc.

In reviewing the bids submitted,

- Compass Minerals America, Inc. - \$128.96/ton
- Compass Minerals America, Inc. - \$158.96/ton
- Morton Salt, Inc. - \$102.04/ton

It is our suggestion to award the bid to Morton Salt, Inc., as the bid price through the KACO Reverse Salt Auction for Morton Salt, Inc. was \$121.26 per ton.
