**A RESOLUTION OF THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT DECLARING
AN END TO THE STATE OF EMERGENCY CONCERNING A PANDEMIC IN 2020**

WHEREAS, in March, 2020, President Donald J. Trump and Governor Andy Beshear declared a state of emergency in response to the novel coronavirus, COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, Judge Executive Reagan Taylor, determined that the emergency response of the County of Madison to the novel coronavirus, COVID-19 pandemic required rapid deployment of resources to protect the health, safety, and welfare of citizens, and by Executive Order 2020-01 declared a local state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the public health threat presented by the novel coronavirus, COVID-19 pandemic, has significantly diminished throughout the United States, Commonwealth of Kentucky, and Madison County; and the need for extraordinary measures no longer exists;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. I, Reagan Taylor, Madison County Judge Executive, by virtue of the authority vested by KRS Chapter 39A and 39B, do declare an end to the local state of emergency as issued on March 16, 2020, in Executive Order 2020-01; as well as any and all additional Executive Orders pertaining to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION.
