Dear Superintendent Gilliam,

The Madison County Fiscal Court confirms road adequacy for the proposed school project and funding responsibility for the required improvements on County right of way subject to the following conditions:

1. The Board of Education shall ensure a Madison County building permit application with the required documentation is submitted to the County for all proposed improvements impacting Meadowbrook Road.
2. All work on County right of way shall be designed by utilizing design parameters approved by the County and final plans are subject to county approval. Plans must be stamped and signed by a Kentucky Professional Engineer.
3. On-site vehicular storage shall be sufficient to prevent backing onto Meadowbrook Road.
4. Madison County Fiscal Court funding responsibility will be limited to work on County right of way. Acquisition of additional right of way and any required utility relocation and design fees shall be the responsibility of the Board of Education.
5. Prior to permit approval, the Board of Education must provide a performance bond or a letter of commitment stating that the contractor's bond will not be released until all work on right of way is approved by Madison County Fiscal Court.
