**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROPOSED
DISCONTINUANCE OF COUNTY ROAD MAINTENANCE**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court is responsible for the maintenance of Madison County roadways; and

WHEREAS, KRS 178.070 outlines the process a county uses for discontinuance of county roadway maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court proposes to remove the following roads without public purpose from the County Road Maintenance System:

- Bethel Branch Spur
- Buffalo Road
- Haden Heights (gravel section)
- Hoodville Lane
- Jackson Branch Road (gravel section/creek bed)
- Old Doylesville Loop

WHEREAS, the Madison County Road Department has assessed all county roads, and this list of roads was recommended by both the road assessment and independent road commissioners on their review;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE EXECUTIVE AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.

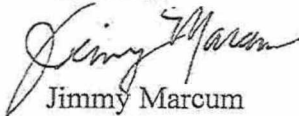
