**A RESOLUTION APPROVING BUDGET AMENDMENTS FOR THE  
FY25 GENERAL ASAP GRANT PER RECOMMENDATION FROM THE  
MADISON COUNTY ASAP BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, the Madison County Fiscal Court, at the request of the Madison County Agency for Substance Abuse Policy (ASAP), assists in providing resources to enhance the health and well-being of the general public by acting as the fiscal agent for the program providing fiscal operation of the Agency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Madison County Fiscal Court passed Resolution 2024-11 on February 13, 2024, to act as the applicant agent for ASAP to make an application to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, Office of Drug Control Policy, for assistance to affect alcohol and substance abuse issues in Madison County and to increase drug prevention and awareness activities funded by the program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Madison County ASAP Board requests to amend the FY25 General ASAP budget and carryovers as follows:
