**A RESOLUTION OF THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT
APPROVING THE PROPOSED DISCONTINUANCE OF THE GRAVEL PORTION
OF HADEN HEIGHTS FROM THE COUNTY ROAD MAINTENANCE SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court is responsible for the maintenance of Madison County roadways; and

WHEREAS, KRS 178.070 outlines the process a county uses for discontinuance of county roadway maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court proposes to remove the following road without public purpose from the County Road Maintenance System:

- Gravel Portion of Haden Heights

WHEREAS, the Madison County Road Department has assessed all county roads, and this gravel portion of the road was recommended by both the road assessment and independent road commissioners on their review;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE/EXECUTIVE AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.

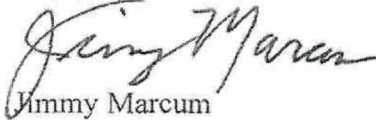
