**A RESOLUTION OF THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT RELATING  
TO SPRING ROAD PAVING OF THE ROADS OUTLINED IN THE COUNTY  
ROAD LIST AS ALLOCATED AND BASED ON THE GREATEST NEED**

**WHEREAS**, the Madison County Fiscal Court (Fiscal Court) recognizes that safe and well-maintained roads, bridges, and infrastructure are fundamental to public safety, economic development, emergency response, school transportation, and the overall quality of life for the citizens of Madison County; and

**WHEREAS**, over the last decade, the Fiscal Court has made an intentional effort to prioritize infrastructure investments, implementing a structured road assessment system, and committing significant funding annually toward road resurfacing, bridge repair, drainage improvements, and long-term capital planning; and

**WHEREAS**, the Madison County Road Department conducts regular road condition assessments utilizing an established rating scale to evaluate pavement condition, structural integrity, drainage performance, and overall safety, allowing the Fiscal Court to prioritize projects based on objective need; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fiscal Court remains committed to a “worst-first” approach, ensuring that available resources are directed toward the roads most in need of rehabilitation to extend pavement life and reduce long-term costs;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT:**

**Section 1.**

The Fiscal Court hereby authorizes the expenditure from existing, available County funds for asphalt resurfacing using the annual bid of \$112.95/ton for asphalt.

**Section 2.**

The funds shall be allocated toward the highest-priority roadways identified in the most recent county road assessment, including the list attached hereto.

**Section 3.**

The County Judge/Executive and the Madison County Road Department are hereby authorized to proceed with scheduling and execution of said paving projects in accordance with all applicable Kentucky Revised Statutes and County purchasing policies.

**Section 4.**

It is the ongoing intent of the Fiscal Court to continue prioritizing infrastructure investment as a core function of county government, recognizing that sustained funding, long-term planning, and

disciplined financial management are essential to maintaining safe roads and protecting taxpayer investments.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE EXECUTIVE AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.**

**EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption by the Madison County Fiscal Court.
