**A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT
APPROVING THE FY27 GENERAL ASAP GRANT BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court (Fiscal Court), passed Resolution 2026-009 on February 10, 2026, to act as the applicant agent for the Madison County Agency for Substance Abuse Policy (ASAP) for assistance with alcohol and substance abuse issues in Madison County and to increase drug prevention and awareness activities funded by the program, with a contingency of approving the budget and expenditures for the 2027 ASAP Funding Year once the grant is awarded; and

WHEREAS, the State ASAP grant has been awarded, and the Fiscal Court wishes to approve the FY27 Madison County ASAP Traditional Funds Budget, which is attached hereto this Resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE/EXECUTIVE AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY; AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT UNDERSTANDS THAT IT WILL SIGN ASSURANCES TO COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL AND STATE LAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS, ESPECIALLY TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT AND SECTION 504 OF THE 1973 REHABILITATION ACT.
