**A RESOLUTION OF THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING A
FUNDING PARTNERSHIP WITH THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO SUPPORT THE ONE-
STOP RESOURCE REFERRAL HUB OF MADISON COUNTY WITH ONE-TIME FUNDING**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court recognizes that mental health challenges, substance use disorders, homelessness, housing instability, and other social service needs continue to impact individuals and families throughout Madison County; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court has demonstrated a longstanding commitment to supporting community service organizations, behavioral health initiatives, recovery programs, public safety partnerships, and efforts to combat the opioid epidemic and mental health crisis affecting our communities; and

WHEREAS, the One-Stop Resource Referral Hub of Madison County serves as a centralized point of access for individuals and families seeking assistance with housing, mental health services, substance abuse treatment, employment resources, healthcare access, transportation assistance, and other critical support services and has become an important component of the community's coordinated response; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky has recognized the value and effectiveness of the One Stop Resource Referral Hub of Madison County through the award of significant state funding and support, demonstrating confidence in the Hub's mission, operations, and impact on the citizens it serves; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has identified a funding gap of Three Hundred Twenty-Seven Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Seven Dollars and Ninety-Two Cents (\$327,197.92) necessary to continue operations and maintain services provided through the One-Stop Resource Referral Hub of Madison County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has requested that the Madison County Fiscal Court participate in a collaborative funding partnership to address this operational funding gap, with each local government contributing fifty percent (50%) of the total amount needed; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court finds that supporting the continued operation of the One-Stop Resource Referral Hub of Madison County serves a valid public purpose by improving access to essential services, reducing barriers to care, strengthening community health and safety, supporting individuals in crisis, and promoting coordinated solutions to complex social challenges affecting Madison County residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Madison County Fiscal Court hereby acknowledges and commends the request of the City of Richmond in sustaining the One-Stop Resource Referral Hub of Madison County and recognizes the positive impact the Hub has had on the citizens of Madison County.

SECTION 2: The Madison County Fiscal Court reaffirms its commitment to supporting community-based solutions that address homelessness, mental health challenges, substance use disorders, and other issues affecting the health, safety, and well-being of Madison County residents.

SECTION 3: The Madison County Fiscal Court authorizes participation in a funding partnership with the City of Richmond to support the continued operation of the One-Stop Resource Referral Hub of Madison County and appropriates an amount equal to fifty percent (50%) of the identified funding gap of Three Hundred Twenty-Seven Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Seven Dollars and Ninety-Two Cents (\$327,197.92), representing a County contribution of One Hundred Sixty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents (\$163,598.96) for FY27.

SECTION 4: The Judge/Executive is authorized to execute any agreements, memoranda of understanding, funding agreements, or related documents necessary to facilitate this partnership and ensure accountability for the expenditure of public funds.

SECTION 5: The Madison County Fiscal Court encourages continued collaboration among the City of Richmond, Madison County Government, the Commonwealth of Kentucky, healthcare providers, nonprofit organizations, public safety agencies, and community partners to strengthen the network of services available to residents in need.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE EXECUTIVE AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.
