**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE JUDGE/EXECUTIVE
TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE DECOMMISSION
OF CSEPP PROPERTY AND TRANSFER OF SAME TO THE COUNTY**

WHEREAS, certain infrastructure was purchased using federal funds as a part of the Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP) for the public safety of the citizens of Madison County; and

WHEREAS, CSEPP is nearing an end; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of CSEPP for the above-referenced infrastructure to remain in Madison County for the benefit of the citizens of Madison County, upon assurances from the County that said infrastructure will continue to be used for public safety purposes; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to retain said infrastructure for the public safety of the citizens of Madison County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE/EXECUTIVE AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO SIGN SUCH DOCUMENTS AND MAKE SUCH ASSURANCES REGARDING THE COUNTY'S INTENT TO CONTINUE TO USE SAID INFRASTRUCTURE FOR PUBLIC SAFETY PURPOSES AS IS REQUIRED BY CSEPP AND/OR THE KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (KYEM).
