**A RESOLUTION OF THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING
THE COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE TO SIGN AGREEMENTS RELATED TO
THE BLUEGRASS RECOVERY INITIATIVE GRANT**

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court (the “County”) recognizes the urgent need for regional strategic planning and enhanced coordination in Prevention, Risk Reduction, Treatment, Recovery, Reentry, and Interdiction activities to address substance use disorder (SUD) and opioid addiction within our Bluegrass Area Development District (BGADD); and

WHEREAS, the County supports the development of the Bluegrass Recovery Initiative, which aims to improve cross-sector communication, workforce development for the SUD population, and access to SUD-related data; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to participate in grant-funded activities as outlined in the partnership between BGADD and our region, including technical assistance, planning, and implementation of opioid abatement strategies as referenced in KRS 15.291(5)(b)(28), KRS 15.293(3)(a), and the Distributor Master Settlement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes that the grant, if awarded, will provide resources for collaborative planning, infrastructure, staffing, training, and oversight to abate the opioid epidemic;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT THAT:

1. The County supports the application for the Bluegrass Recovery Initiative grant and the objectives described therein.
2. The Madison County Judge/Executive is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the County, any and all agreements, memoranda of understanding, or related documents necessary to implement the grant, contingent upon award and subject to review by legal counsel.
3. If the grant is awarded, the County agrees to contribute \$5,000.00 to the grant agreement.
4. This authority shall remain in effect for the duration of the grant opportunity and any subsequent renewals or amendments related to the Bluegrass Recovery Initiative.
