**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN UPDATED INFORMATION SECURITY POLICY
AND REPLACING PRIOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY POLICIES
ESTABLISHED UNDER RESOLUTION NO. 2016-11**

WHEREAS, Madison County, Kentucky is responsible for safeguarding sensitive information, including Criminal Justice Information (CJI), and ensuring the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of all its information systems; and

WHEREAS, the threat landscape affecting local governments has evolved significantly since the adoption of prior information technology policies under Resolution No. 2016-11; and

WHEREAS, Madison County has developed a comprehensive Information Security Policy on a standards-based approach aligned with nationally recognized frameworks, including the CJIS Security Policy, NIST SP 800-53, and Center for Internet Security Critical Security Controls; and

WHEREAS, these updated policies establish a structured and risk-based framework for managing information security, including access control, incident response, system integrity, personnel security, physical security, and governance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE/EXECUTIVE AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.
