MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR MUTUAL AID FOR INTER-AGENCY  
EMERGENCY SERVICES DISPATCH SUPPORT BETWEEN MADISON COUNTY,  
KENTUCKY (COUNTY), AND THE U.S. ARMY, BLUE GRASS ARMY DEPOT**

**WHEREAS**, the County and the Blue Grass Army Depot, referred to collectively as the "Parties," wish to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for Inter-Agency Emergency Services Dispatch Support; and

**WHEREAS**, the Madison County Public Safety Advisory Board (PSAB) voted unanimously during a special called PSAB meeting on July 22, 2026, that it would be in the best interest of the Parties to enter into said Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties agree to receive and transfer all 911 calls that originate from within the boundaries of Blue Grass Army Depot when necessary, as outlined in the Mutual Aid Agreement (MAA);

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FISCAL COURT DOES HEREBY APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZES THE JUDGE/EXECUTIVE AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.**

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
DIRECTORATE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES,  
BLUE GRASS ARMY DEPOT, RICHMOND, KENTUCKY  
AND  
PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINT, MADISON COUNTY, KENTUCKY**

**SUBJECT: Mutual Aid Agreement for Inter-Agency Emergency Services Dispatch Support**

1. Purpose: This is a Mutual Aid Agreement (MAA) between Madison County, KY, and the U.S. Army, Blue Grass Army Depot. When referred to collectively, the Blue Grass Army Depot and Madison County are referred to as the "Parties." In consideration of the following terms and conditions, the Parties agree to receive and transfer all 911 calls that originate from within the boundaries of Blue Grass Army Depot as follows.

**2. AUTHORITIES:**

- a. Kari's Law and Ray Baums Act.
- b. Army Regulation 25-50, Preparing and Managing Correspondence.
- c. TM 3-11.42 Multi-Service Tactics, Techniques, and Procedures for Emergency Management, 28 July 2021
- d. AR 5-9 Installation Agreements, 17 Apr 2018.
- e. Department of Defense Instruction (DoDI) 4000.19, Support Agreements, 16 Dec 2020.

**3. DEFINITIONS OF TERMS:**

- a. Madison County: The Madison County Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP), identified as the local PSAP for emergency 9-1-1 calls.
- b. Madison County Representatives: Jeremy Hamm, Director of Public Safety
- c. Blue Grass Army Depot Representatives: Directorate of Emergency Services, PSAP/ECC/Dispatch, Fire and Emergency Services, Emergency Medical Services, Directorate of Information Management.

**4. GENERAL.**

a. Scope. Madison County will receive 9-1-1 calls that originate from within the boundaries of Blue Grass Army Depot and conference the caller with the Blue Grass Army Depot Dispatch. Madison County will provide Blue Grass Army Depot with the location of the caller and pertinent call details, ensuring a smooth call hand-off. Blue Grass Army Depot will provide all dispatching services for its own first responder assets.

b. Limitations. If the call conference cannot be accomplished, secondary communications will be completed through a designated Land Mobile Radio (LMR) frequency/channel/talk group.

**5. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

## SUBJECT: Inter-Agency Emergency Services Dispatch Support Agreement

### a. Madison County:

(1) Receive all 9-1-1 calls that originate from within the boundaries of Blue Grass Army Depot.

(2) Conference 9-1-1 calls that originate from within the boundaries of Blue Grass Army Depot to the appropriate Depot emergency dispatcher.

(3) Maintain primary PSAP accreditation.

(4) Maintain access for Blue Grass Army Depot to the designated LMR frequency/channel/talk group.

### b. Blue Grass Army Depot:

(1) Provide a dedicated phone line to Madison County for call conferencing.

(2) Provide dispatch services for all Blue Grass Army Depot emergency responses.

6. RECOGNITION OF QUALIFICATIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS: The Parties are responsible for their own training, certifications, and credentialing, but are encouraged to conduct joint training when possible.

7. PERSONNEL: Each Party is responsible for all the costs of its personnel, including pay and benefits, support, and travel. Each Party is responsible for the supervision and management of its personnel.

### 8. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

a. POINTS OF CONTACT (POCs): The following points of contact (POC) will be used by the Parties to communicate in the implementation of this MAA.

b. MODIFICATION. This MAA may only be modified by the written agreement of the Parties, duly signed by their authorized representatives. This MAA will be reviewed no less often than at the mid-point of its term and around the anniversary of its effective date.

SUBJECT: Inter-Agency Emergency Services Dispatch Support Agreement

c. DISPUTES. Should a dispute arise between the Parties related to this MAA, the Parties agree to attempt to resolve the dispute through negotiations. If negotiations reach an impasse, the Parties will forward the disagreement to a senior official within their respective organizations for resolution.

d. TERMINATION. This MAA may be terminated in writing at will by either party with a 90-day written notice to the other Party.

e. TRANSFERABILITY. This MAA is not transferable except with the written consent of the Parties.

f. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This MAA embodies the entire understanding between the Parties regarding this subject matter, superseding all prior understandings.

g. EFFECTIVE DATE. This MAA takes effect beginning on the day after the last Party signs.

h. EXPIRATION DATE. This MAA expires ten (10) years after the effective date unless renewed or terminated.

i. NO THIRD-PARTY BENEFICIARIES. Nothing in this MAA is intended to confer upon any person, not a party any remedy or claim under or by reason of this MAA.

9. SEVERABILITY: If any term or provision of this MAA is held to be invalid or unenforceable, such term shall be deemed severed, and all remaining terms shall continue in full force and effect.

10. FINANCIAL: This MAA does not provide for reimbursement between the Parties.
