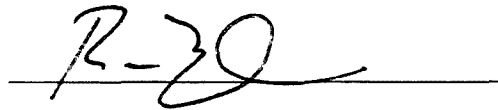
Motion made by Roger Barger seconded by John Tudor to approve pay claims and transfers
